at "The Knowe" 4 Clarkmont Road, Sassafras (Melways 66 D12).

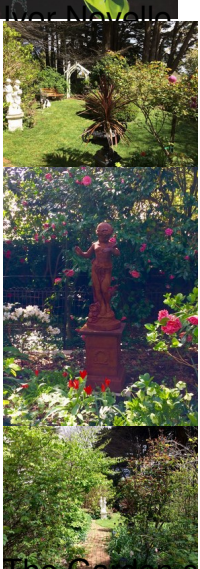
